

Amazon Sued For Using Facial Recognition On New Yorkers Without Permission

In “Amazon Sued For Using Facial Recognition On New Yorkers Without Permission” (Fox 5, March 17, 2023), Fox5 covers the class-action lawsuit against Amazon. The plaintiff claims that the company did not inform its Amazon Go customers that it was using facial recognition technology at its NYC locations.

The lawsuit was filed Thursday March 16, 2023 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on behalf of shopper Alfredo Rodriguez Perez by Pollock Cohen LLP, Peter Romer-Friedman Law PLLC, and the Surveillance Technology Oversight Project. The case is Perez v. Amazon.com, Inc., S.D.N.Y., No. 1:23-cv-02251.
