

Amazon.com Starbucks Biometric Privacy Class Action

"Amazon.com Starbucks Biometric Privacy Class Action" (June 8, 2023) covers the biometric privacy class action against Amazon.com and Starbucks June 7, 2023 in Washington Western District Court. The complaint was filed by Pollock Cohen LLP along with Bursor & Fisher, Riverside Law Group, Peter Romer-Friedman Law, and the Surveillance Technology Oversight Project (S.T.O.P.) on behalf of customers using Starbucks-Amazon Go's 'cashierless' technology, which has been used to collect palm scans and other biometric data and share that data with third parties.

The case is 2:23-cv-00852, Mallouk et al v. Amazon.com Inc et al
