Tax whistleblower attorney Adam Pollock, Managing Partner at Pollock Cohen LLP, commented on the tax features of New York's False Claims Act: “It's actually very rare to see a frivolous FCA tax case,” said Pollock, an alum of the state's Taxpayer Protection Bureau.
