In "How 2nd Circ. Ruling Fortifies Plaintiff Standing Arguments" (Law360, September 13, 2023), our firm along with co-authors discuss the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit's precedential decision on Article III standing in *Bohnak v Marsh & McLennan*. The decision confirms that a plaintiff can have Article III standing to seek damages under the U.S. Supreme Court's 2021 *TransUnion LLC v Ramirez* ruling based on the risk of future harm, which itself can be a concrete injury.
