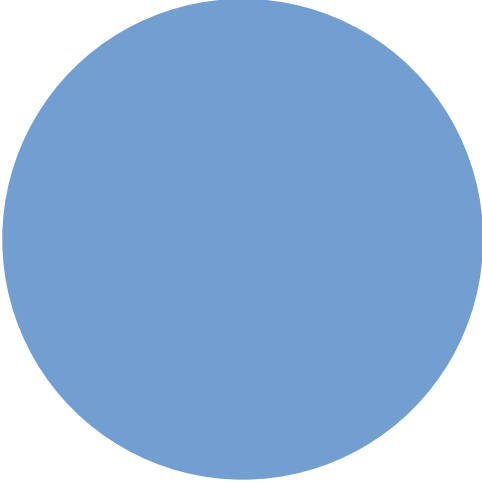




Eliza Davis
